

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects

CHINOISERIE SUNFLOWER DISH



MATERIALS

CCX088 Round Sunflower Dish
Fan Brush
Medium Brush
Yellow Sponge

COLORS

CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 64 - Sky Blue CMM 43 - Saffire CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a fan brush to paint one coat of Saffire all over the Sunflower dish, including the back.
- 2. Dip the sponge into water and squeeze out the excess water.
- 3. Wipe the sunflower dish with the sponge to remove the paint from the raised area, this will leave color only in the crevices.
- 4. Thin down the remaining colors (Deep Sea, Sky Blue, and Blue Lagoon) with 50% water to 50% paint. We will use the watered-down colors for the remaining steps.
- 5. Use a medium brush to apply one coat of paint to the petals. We used both Deep Sea and Blue Lagoon.
- 6. Next, paint the center of the flower with 1 coat of Sky Blue.
- 7. When the front is dry, flip the bowl over.
- 8. Apply 1 generous coat of Sky Blue to the entire back of the bowl.

TIPS

- The darker color will come through during the firing process.
- It's okay to allow these colors to mix and blend together. They're all blue and work well with each other.
